Raising and Improving Self Sufficiency Expectations (R.I.S.E)

Informational/Fact Sheet

What is the R.I.S.E Program?

The goal of the R.I.S.E. Program is to assist motivated individuals and families to progress towards economic stability and self-sufficiency via way of employment. The way that we accomplish this is by providing support services such as: case management, college education, job skills training, credit management workshops, childcare assistance, limited transportation assistance, and other services to eligible customers, based upon need and availability of resources.

Who May Apply?

- Must be residents of Alachua, Levy, or Marion County
- Must be able to provide proof of residency and show proof of all income for members of the household
- Must meet the program's income guidelines, as issued by the State/Federal Government standards
- Must be able to attend school, trade program, college and/or work between 20-40 hours per week
- Must have reliable transportation or able to utilize public transportation systems
- Customer must agree to all programmatic requirements, such as, assessments, workshops, and contract compliance

Please note that an application does NOT guarantee admission into the program
